- I. Objections must be submitted in writing to the secretaries box within 15 minutes of the class ending and be accompanied by a deposit of £50 per complaint which will be refunded if the objection is upheld by the committee.
- II. All riders must wear hard hats at all times, correct clothing and suitable footwear. Hard hats must conform to the current British standard and chin straps securely fastened. In the jumping ring BS rulings regarding tack apply.
- III. All junior competitors must wear a hard hat, up to the current standard in all rings.
- IV. No horse / pony under four years old can enter a ridden class.
- V. The entry of stallions is permitted and should be notified to the committee before the day of the show and be identified as a stallion on the showground.
- VI. Children under the age of three years are not permitted to compete in any class
- VII. All competitors in the jumping classes must have attained their fourth birthday.
- VIII. Neither the organising committee of Cliviger Riding Club nor any members thereof will accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, ponies, owners, riders, handlers, spectators or members of the public & their possessions.
- IX. The committee has the right to refuse the entry of any horse / pony or any rider / handler that is showing being detrimental towards the club or causing danger to any other participants.
- X. Entry fees are none refundable unless in extreme circumstances of genuine injury to horse / rider on show day and at the discretion of the committee.
- XI. The misuse of whips and spurs will not be tolerated. For jumping spurs must be worn correctly as in the BS rules.
- XII. All horses / ponies must be in fit and good condition or will be asked to leave the showground.
- XIII. Any animal that is deemed as not under control will be asked to leave the showground.
- XIV. The jumping ring runs under BS rules.
- XV. The same combination of horse / pony and rider / handler must be maintained at two out of five shows attended to qualify for points.
- XVI. Animals left unattended is done so at the owners responsibility.
- XVII. Jumping classes will be run as single-phase with the exception of class 10 which will be over the first 8 fences, one round only and all clears to share 1<sup>st</sup> place.
- XVIII. We can accept cash or card on show day.
- XIX. Adults are not allowed to work in childrens ponies before their class

### **Points for Members are rewarded as follows:**

1st = 6pts 2<sup>nd</sup> = 5pts 3<sup>rd</sup> = 4pts 4<sup>th</sup> = 3pts  
(Classes 38 to 47) 5<sup>th</sup> = 2pts 6<sup>th</sup> = 1pts

One point will be given to each unplaced member entering the ring per class.

# Ring 1 - Large Outdoor Arena

## Showjumping main outdoor arena commences at 9am

Junior classes: ponies not exceeding 148cm & riders not to have attained their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday before 01/01/2024

Senior classes: seniors riding horse or pony. Junior riders welcome on horses over 148cm

Clear Round – 50cm (£3.00 per round entries open until 9:15am to be paid at the ringside)

1. 50cm (open to both Junior & Senior riders)
2. Junior 60cm
3. Senior 60cm
4. Junior 70cm
5. Senior 70cm
6. Junior 80cm
7. Senior 80cm
8. Open 90cm
9. 30cm (jockey aged 4 – 10 yrs ponies not to exceed 148cm. Lead rein welcome)
10. Novice 40cm (any combination of horse / rider. Riders will be allowed to complete the course at the judges discretion. (If you enter this class then the same combination can't enter classes 7, 8 or 9)

## Warm up areas

Show jumping and working hunter warm up is in the small outdoor arena.

Working in is on the RIGHT rein

Please shout out your jump before approaching to allow others to know your intention

Please declare your number and class to the ring steward on entry into the warm up ring

Ridden Classes working in is in the small indoor

Childrens working in is in the cordoned area at the bottom of the large indoor arena

Inhand working in is in the pen adjacent to the small indoor

Please refrain from loitering in the areas specifically set out for working in
